Total fee for weekend is \$190 which includes 2 nights lodging and meals (Saturday breakfast to Sunday lunch).

***A change this year - the way to sign up is to complete the attached registration form and get it to Leslie Carson either through mailbox at church, handing it to me in person, or emailing it to carsonsl@maine.rr.com. Please get it in by February 18, 2024 as Calumet needs 2 weeks notice. You will pay in full when you arrive. The registration asks your preference for roommate. To keep cost down, when possible, they are encouraging folks to buddy up.

Friday March 1

You can check into Calumet after 4pm.

Instead of going out to dinner (which you can still do on your own), plan to gather for snacks/ charcuterie fellowship at Calumet. Bring something to share. In the upstairs lounge there is a large fridge and a microwave. We'll make sure to separate the gluten free from regular. Real casual. A more formal start of activities is around 8-830pm.

Directions- Take route 16 north from the Seacoast until you come to West Ossipee-approximately 60 miles from Holy Trinity. You will see McDonalds, the Yankee Smokehouse, Hobbs Tavern then a blinking light. Take this right onto route 41. Go about ½ mile. Stay sharp and turn right onto lake Ossipee Road (Small Calumet sign on corner). Calumet is 2.7 miles down this road. Turn left into the Conference Center Parking lot which is the first entrance.

Saturday

Morning session starts around 9:00am. Yoga at 7am for early risers.

Make sure to bring comfortable clothes. Bring layers so that you can enjoy some of the great outdoors, weather permitting and tolerate the various temps in the rooms. They have some equipment available at Calumet like snowshoes, skates and tubes but no cross country skis. The weather in March is always iffy. We can have snow or mud. Other things to bring

- ⇒Comfortable shoes, slippers (shoes must be worn at all times in the dining hall)
- ⇒Comfortable outfit to stretch, do yoga. Calumet has some mats
- ⇒Money to shop in the Calumet store/ your payment for the weekend
- ⇒Boots for outdoor conditions
- ⇒Hats, gloves
- ⇒Clipboard to write on if you have one
- ⇒Towels and bed linens provided.
- ⇒Optional Your favorite (not too complicated) game
- ⇒Snack for Friday night
- ⇒Please leave your scents at home as many people are sensitive.

Saturday afternoon you can explore Calumet and its grounds. We'll have a craft or just hang and relax. Saturday night plan on games, trivia and more crafting.

We do a brief closing. Church service is at 10:00am. Lunch is served at noon.
